The Era of ChatGPT: What Generative AI Could Mean for the Legal World.

It's too early to divine the impact of Generative AI models like ChatGPT on the legal industry but some early attempts at integrating these models into legal workflows have shown promise. Magic Circle firm Allen & Overy has already rolled out its own chatbot, Harvey, leaving many industry insiders to speculate that such AI deployments could become standard practice across the wider legal industry.

ChatGPT has proven that it can answer complex legal queries, help draft opening remarks and unshackle human capital expended on mundane and manual tasks. But those who embrace its use, must proceed with caution. These Generative AI models are not without fault as anyone who has used ChatGPT can attest to. It could spell trouble for those treating it as their singular source of truth.

In this talk, we will explore the advantages and perilous limitations encapsulated in the most talked-about technology since the beginning of the internet.
